2011. január 1-jén hatályba lépett a 267/2006. Korm. rendelet módosítása, amely rendezte a Magyar Állami Földtani Intézet (MÁFI) szervezeti helyzetét azzal, hogy az Eötvös Loránd Geofizikai Intézet (ELGI) hasonlóan egyes középírányítói jogokat a Magyar Bányászati és Földtani Hivatalhoz (MBFH) rendelt. Ezzel helyreállt a földtani intézményrendszer korábbi struktúrája.

A Huntek szakcsoport alapító tagjai levélben fordultak a Magyarhoni Földtani Társulat elnökéhez, amelyben jelezték, hogy tevékenységüket szívesen folytatnák a társulat keretein belül. Az elnökség elfogadta azt a javaslatot, hogy a Huntek ad hoc interdiszciplináris fórumként működjön, és azt tanácsolja az alapítónak, hogy tevékenységüket az Általános Földtani Szakosztály technikai segítségével végezzék.

Prof. Dr. János GEIGER

Honorary member of the Croatian Geological Society

On 15th December, at the annual meeting of the Croatian Geological Society, Prof. Dr. János GEIGER from Szeged University was elected to be an Honorary Member of the Croatian Geological Society.

There are a lot of special reasons and events for the Croatian geologists, which of course cannot be all listed here, that show his humanity, good will and true effort for developing friendship and cooperation. These were the reasons why six of Croatian colleagues, all from Geomathematical Section of the Croatian Geological Society, prepared a proposal for the annual meeting of the Croatian Geological Society to elect Prof. GEIGER as Honorary Member. These six members are (in alphabetical order): Davorin BALIĆ, Marko CVETKOVIĆ, Nediljko KOLAK, Prof. Dr. Tomislav MALVIĆ, Kristina NOVAK ZELENKA and Igor RUSAN.

Our main motivations of this proposal were as follows:

1. Encouraging and organizing mutual Croatian–Hungarian geomathematical congresses from 2008.
2. From the 1st congress he involved as one of the organizers of the Croatian Geological Society.
3. Faculty of Mining, Geology and Petroleum Engineering, University of Zagreb has been a permanent sponsor from the 2nd Congress.
4. Geomathematical Section of the Croatian society is permanently active in Organizational committee and program of congresses.
5. Prof. GEIGER directly supported and helped establishing of the Croatian Geomathematical Section, hosting Croatian members many times in Mórahalom and in Szeged.

But all of the above listed are only parts of activities that he made with or for Croatian geological community. Here are some other remarkable achievements.

1. Support publishing activities of Croatian geomathematical section members in Hungarian journals: Central European Geol-

ogy (Acta Geologica Hungarica) and Bulletin of the Hungarian Geological Society (Földtani Közlöny). He also gladly reviewed such papers.

2. He published together with Croatian colleagues in Croatian journals and international congresses (IAMG and Croatian geological congress).

3. He is the reviewer of the Croatian geological journals: "Nafta" (Oil) and Geologia Croatica (also as Associate Editor).

4. He is a member of the committee for a particular doctoral thesis at the University of Zagreb on the fields of geomathematics and geology.

5. He actively supported cooperation between the Department of Geology and Geological Engineering at the Faculty of Mining, Geology and Petroleum Engineering in Zagreb and Department of Geology and Palaeontology at the University of Szeged, in the form of mutual publishing and postgraduate student exchange.

6. He encouraged members of the Croatian Geological Society to apply for a membership in the Hungarian Geological Society or in the IAMG Student Chapter Szeged.

7. He invited Croatian colleagues to participate in the Managing Board of the Hungarian Geomathematical Section.

8. He actively took part, with colleagues, at the Croatian Geological Congress in 2010.

Due to all presented, the above mentioned six members of the Croatian Geological Society, concluded and proposed at annual meeting in December 2010:

"(We) consider that Prof. GEIGER with the activities presented in explanation of our proposal, provided extraordinary contribution in activity of Croatian Geological Society at international level, and especially promotion of Croatian geology in Hungary.

As his second great contribution (we) support and help establishing geomathematics in Croatian geology and its institutional recognizing through establishment of the Geomathematical Section of the Croatian Geological Society".

We hope that this award will help maintaining strong and stable historical connections between Hungarian and Croatian geological societies.
